#### **Horned Frog Academic Quick Facts (Fall 2008)**

- All Sport Team GPA for the Fall 2008 semester is 2.944 (up from 2.91 in Spring 2008) the highest since reporting began in Fall 1998.
- The Fall 2008 departmental cumulative GPA of 2.932 is up from the 2.89 posted in the Spring 2008 semester – the highest since reporting began in Fall 1998.
- After the Fall 2003 semester there were only 5 teams over a 3.00 GPA. After the most recent Fall 2008 semester, the TCU Athletics Department can boast 12 teams over the 3.00 mark and 17 over the 2.90 mark.
- 31 Horned Frog student-athletes graduated at the December 2008 commencement ceremony while 82 student-athletes graduated in the most recent 2007-2008 academic year.
- 20 Horned Frog student-athletes were named recipients of the Fall 2008 TCU Scholar Award (perfect 4.00 while being enrolled full-time).
- 83 Horned Frog student-athletes were named Fall 2008 Dean's List Recipients.
- 26 student-athletes earned a perfect semester GPA of 4.000.
- 27% of all student-athletes earned a semester GPA of 3.50 or higher.
- 43% of all student-athletes earned a semester GPA of 3.20 or higher.
- 55% of all student-athletes earned a semester GPA of 3.00 or higher.
- 45 Horned Frog student-athletes named to the Fall 2008 Academic All-MWC Team.
- 2 former TCU student-athletes were named recipients of the NCAA Degree Completion Award for the Spring 2009 semester....7 for the year (5 graduated in December).
- 4 TCU student-athletes honored as 2008 recipients of the Arthur Ashe Jr. Sport Scholar Award (Ervin Dickerson Jr. – 1<sup>st</sup> team Football; Andrea Morgado – 1<sup>st</sup> team Women's Tennis; David Hawthorne Jr. – 3<sup>rd</sup> team Football; Michelle Nguyen – 4<sup>th</sup> team Women's Soccer).
- 59 Horned Frog student-athletes named to the Spring 2008 Academic All-MWC Team.
- TCU Freshman Melissa Loh has been named an All-America Scholar by the National Golf Coaches Association of America (Spring 2008).
- Eligibility – this year 653/4 (0.6%)...2004-05 was 618/18 (3%).
