

## Help TCU reduce move-out waste

ReFrog is a TCU Sustainability Committee volunteer initiative whose mission is to make TCU's move-out process more sustainable by diverting usable items from the landfill to community members.

Students, alumni, parents, faculty, and staff were dismayed to see that in the rush to move out, many students discard perfectly usable items into overflowing dumpsters. In 2023, we teamed up with partners on and off campus to rescue these items from the landfill and get them into the hands of people and organizations who will continue using them.

## 2023 impact

- 100 volunteers over four days
- 140 volunteer hours
- 240 students donated over 2,000 items
- 420 items ReFrogged to shoppers
- 50 items donated to TRIO career business attire pop-up
- The Welman Project helped us get four dumpsters worth of items to 90 local educators impacting 1,800 Fort Worth kids
