## Resolution on the formation of an Integrative Artificial Intelligence Committee:

The Academic Excellence Committee of the TCU Faculty Senate has, for this academic year, been discussing generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) as it relates to effective pedagogy, to student competencies, and to academic integrity. This protean new technology offers tremendous potential benefits along with perilous challenges. As student usage becomes normalized and faculty options become more complex, the AEC recommends that TCU form a new university committee--composed of faculty, staff, and students—dedicated to the healthy integration of Artificial Intelligence into the fabric of the university. Such a committee would be a clearing-house for up-to-date recommendations on the many facets of this technology as it relates to TCU. The Integrative Artificial Intelligence Committee would address the following charges:

- (1) Articulate appropriate and ethical uses of AI.
- (2) Monitor privacy and data security issues associated with AI.
- (3) Recommend faculty/student/staff training modules on AI.
- (4) Recommend institutional investments in AI.
- (5) Formulate policies that support the alignment of AI with the academic excellence commitments of the University.
- (6) Facilitate community partnerships to ensure a comprehensive understanding of AI-related applications in industry.
